- Higher education school of economics was opened in 1960/1961
- Pedagogical Academy in Pula in 1961/1962
- Juraj Dobrila University of Pula was founded on the 11th of October, 2006
- Around 3500 students and 265 employees (195 academic and 70 admin staff)
- External professors – around 150 (part time teaching)

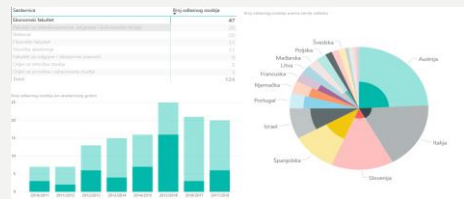
