





Most international students need an Austrian bank account to pay their rent to their landlord or student dorm (e.g. via simple transfer or via direct debit authorization/"Einzugsermächtigung").

Please make an appointment with a bank of your choice beforehand.

To open a bank account, your buddies must bring:

- . Confirmation of admission/enrollment ("Inskriptionsbestätigung")

Student bank accounts are usually free of charge.

- Students from EU/EEA countries and Switzerland usually have insurance coverage for acute illnesses/injuries with their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).
- Students from certain countries (e.g., Turkey) have to obtain the form A3 from their national health insurance in their home country. Once they are in Austria, they can exchange this A3 form for forms entitling them to medical treatment at the *Tiroler Gebietskrankenkosse (TGKK)*.
- Students from "third countries" should already have international health insurance valid in Austria (= Studen's from _incord norm _incord norm _incord norm _incord near norm _incord near norm _incord norm _incord
- Another possibility is to take out **private health insurance**. It is essential that the insurance complies with a few requirements (insurance must pay for medical treatment in Austria directly etc). For possibilities see here: www.fessfasa.or/www.care-concept.de.
- It is important that all your buddies have health insurance valid in Austria throughout their stay!
