



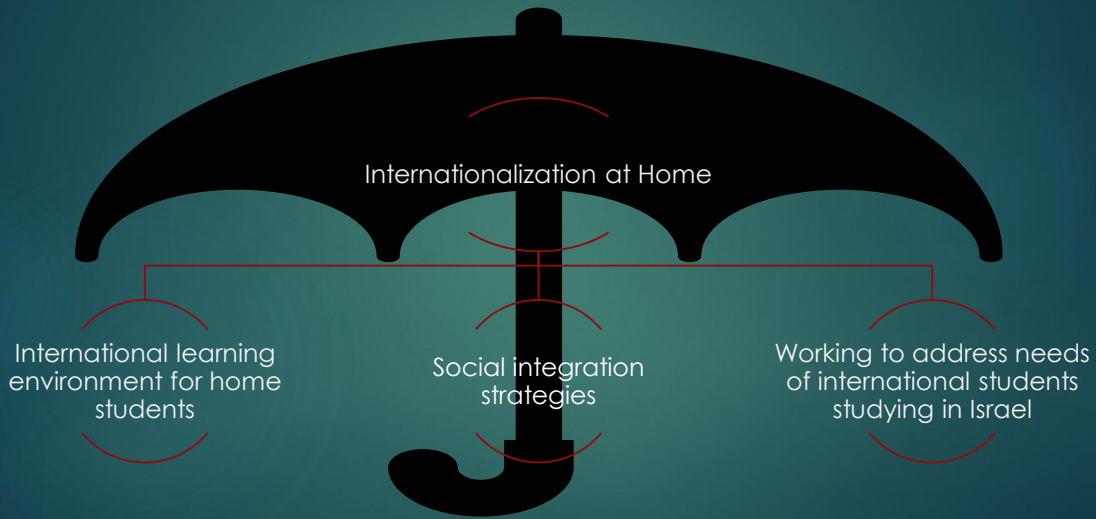

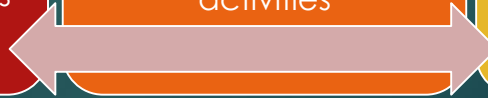

Int'l Experience of Home Students

-At least 1 Virtual International Classroom developed and piloted

-Ways you intend to promote an International campus, include for example events you will have, website improvements, promotional video (MUNI will offer tips and training for this).

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Template: Activity area requirements



Social Integration

-Develop and implement 2-3 initiatives to advance social integration of local and International students (either in the academic or non-academic setting).

(e.g. buddy system, programming, internships...)

-Create 1-2 marketing campaigns to promote social integration activities.

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Template: Activity area requirements



Addressing needs of international students studying at your institution

-Devise 2-3 new or significantly improved protocols/guidelines for:

- incoming student services
- safety and security

-Faculty and/or administrative staff training to create a more supportive and inclusive learning environment for international students. How many trainings? How many staff members?

Note: types of training – consortium level and institutional level, we can decide to do in part together – sucti/safety and security.
