Internationalization at Home and social engagement

In 2019, three trainers from Erasmus Student Network (ESN) held a series of trainings in Israel, which led to the creation of action plans at the participating institutions. The planned follow-up trainings, planned for 2020, were cancelled due to the Covid-19 restrictions, and will now be held online instead. The focus of the training will be “buddy systems”, including recruitment, training of buddies and volunteer engagement. By the end of the training, the participants will have learned more about how to create a welcoming environment for international students.

Target group

This training is for the institutions that are part of the WILLIAM project. The target group is both students and staff who are, or will be, involved in working on the topic of Internationalization at Home in the future. Those who have followed the WILLIAM project are very much invited, but other staff/students are very welcome too.
