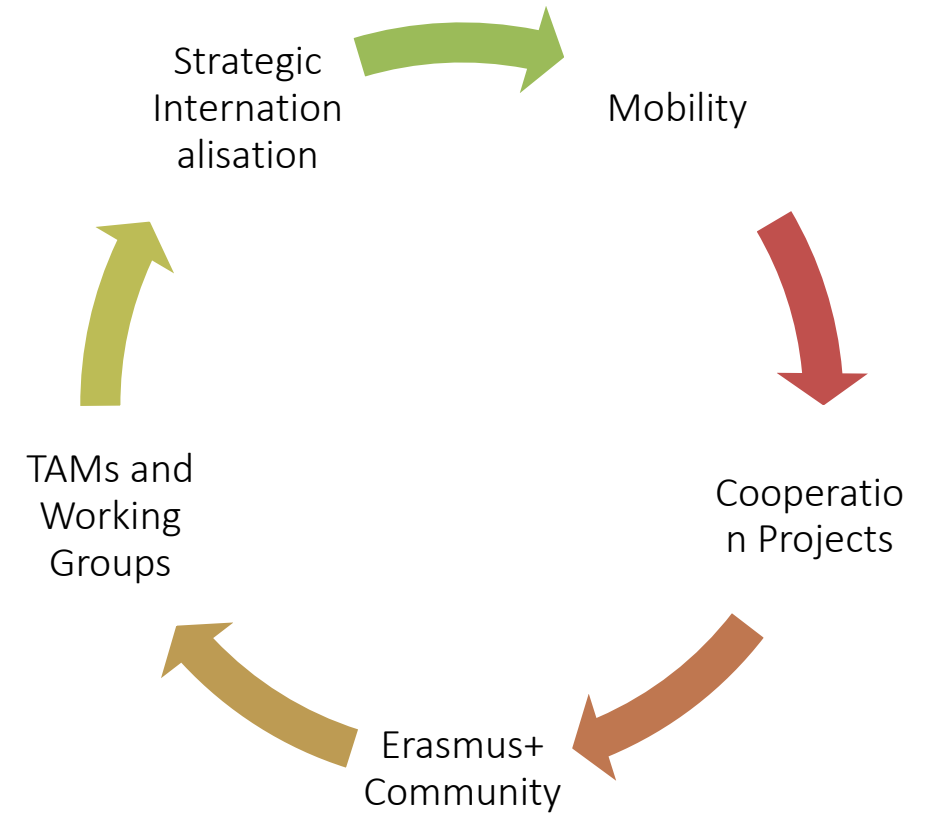
- Following the Round table with The CHE updated its policy and instructed all HEIs that request funding for international programmes to create a contact base that goes at least 10 years back of international alumni.

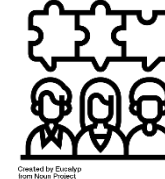
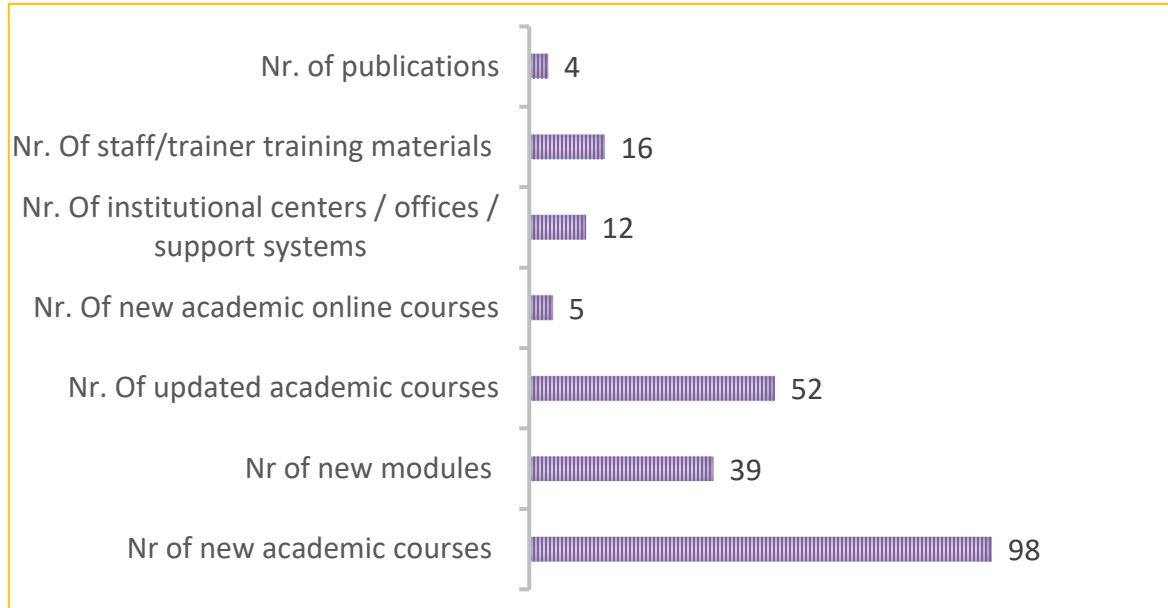

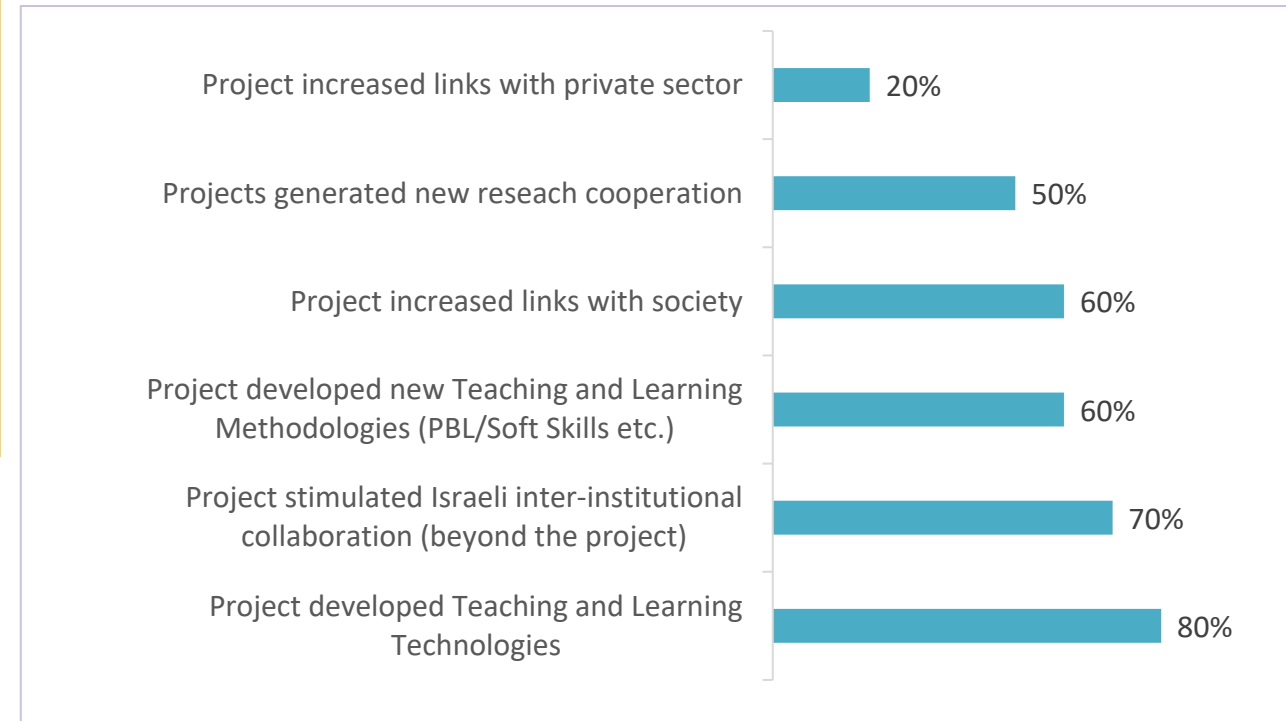
Our approach to assessment: 360° impact



2015-2020 Impact study



22 projects selected
10 selected for the study



55% of respondents state there are **non-project departments** that implement outputs
42% of respondents state there are **non-consortium HEIs** that implement outputs



CBHE Objective: support the modernisation, accessibility and internationalization of higher education in the eligible Partner Countries



- 90% advance national and international academic collaborations
- 89% advance knowledge sharing
- 87% promote intercultural awareness
- 86% advance student / faculty skills and competencies



- 93% increased academic collaboration with other Israeli HEIs
- 87% increased internationalization capacities
- 87% improved quality of teaching and learning
- 85% enhanced 21st century / soft skills



- 75% implement new teaching skills and methods
- 86% expanded their international academic network
- 75% collaborate with colleagues from IL HEIs
- 70% use new technologies in their teaching

CBHE Objectives:

support eligible Partner Countries to address the challenges facing their higher education institutions and systems, including those of quality, relevance, equity of access, planning, delivery, management and governance



- 82% CBHE provide an initial/additional boost to address national and /or institutional challenges
- 87% improved quality of teaching and learning
- 80% improved the quality of higher education institutions (HEIs) through curriculum development



CBHE Objectives:

contribute to cooperation between the EU and the eligible Partner Countries (and amongst the eligible Partner Countries);



- 90% advance national and international academic collaborations
- 89% advance knowledge sharing



- 86% expanded their international academic network
- 93% increased academic collaboration with other Israeli HEIs

CBHE Objectives:

promote people-to-people contacts, intercultural awareness and understanding



- 87% promote intercultural awareness

- 64% more confident teaching in an inter-cultural classroom

- 56% more aware of the importance of inclusion


promote voluntary convergence with EU developments in higher education



- 57% implement Bologna elements (ECTS, learning outcomes, student centered learning)

What's next?



- Continuation of Capacity Building in HE, International Credit Mobility, Erasmus Mundus (EMJM+EMDM), new local HERE forum
 - More inclusive, diverse and virtual mobility (virtual exchanges call, blended mobility in ICM, PhD students can participate in ICM)
 - Emphasis on regional priorities: Green Deal, digital transformation, Migration and Mobility, Sustainable growth and jobs, Governance, peace, security and human development
